## New Globe had the privilege to handle and export shipment of 2 Soilmec Rig

New Globe Logistik Pvt. Ltd. had the privilege to handle and export shipments of 2 Soilmec Rigs from Mumbai to Singapore. The Rigs were weighing 50,590 kgs & 38,200 kgs i.e. a total shipment of 88,790kgs. The shipment was customs cleared and handed over to the NYC liners on time i.e. 09<sup>th</sup> Jan 2013 - but due to the delay in arrival of the vessel to Mumbai port, the cargo was kept in the port under supervision till 20<sup>th</sup> Jan,2013. Immediately on berthing of the vessel on 20<sup>th</sup> Jan we arranged the movement and loaded the cargo into the vessel under the liners supervision. The same was done in the nick of time, as the vessel was sailing same evening and we had very little time for movement as this type of cargo requires to be self-driven inside the deck of the vessel and proper lashing to be done to avoid any damage to the vehicle. The rigs were loaded on level 5 of the vessel which had a total of 12 levels to load such odd size cargo. The exporter Kamar Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd were very happy with the handling of the shipment from our end.

## Steps to establish an air cargo complex at Mangalore airport is gathering momentum with a Government

In a notification dated January 31, the Department of Customs has notified the air cargo complex at Mangalore airport. Mohammed Ameen, President of the Kanara Chamber of Commerce and Industry, said KCCI has been demanding this facility at Mangalore airport for a long time. With this notification, flow of air cargo despatches from Mangalore airport to various overseas destinations will begin. This will encourage exporters and manufacturers of consumable items. The notification will help export agricultural, horticultural and fisheries products from Mangalore and strengthen the economy, he said. M. R. Vasudeva, co-ordinator of Karnataka NRI Forum in Mangalore, said this notification will permit the import and export from Mangalore airport.
